## **ILOs (Individual Learning Opportunities)**

During each of the 5 LEAP sessions, students either engage in reinforcement material to support content or participate in an ILO, or Individual Learning Opportunity, thus individualizing their experience. For students who have demonstrated a gap in knowledge, LEAP provides time and faculty support, and in some cases a re-assessment focused on their particular gap. If the student is cleared for an ILO, this five-day period allows total immersion in specialized topics designed by faculty to promote a deeper dive into a curricular area, support skill building, and/or career exploration. It also allows students the opportunity to have a valuable experience and learn outside of the curriculum, including options in the humanities. Below are examples of some of the ILOs that have been offered in the past, however ILO options change each LEAP session.
